## Housekeeping notes

### Arriving in East London

On arrival in East London, collect your luggage and proceed to the arrivals hall. A shuttle service will be provided for delegates who, when registering, indicated that they require a shuttle service. Look out for the IMESA airport shuttle banner and identify yourself. The shuttle will take you to the below hotels, or directly to the East London ICC (ELICC). Most hotel check-in times are after 14:00.

- **Regent Premier Hotel** – 11 m from ELICC
- **Kennaway Hotel** – 240 m from ELICC
- **Osner Hotel** – 800 m from ELICC
- **King David Hotel** – 1.1 km from ELICC
- **Garden Court** – 1.1 km from ELICC
- **Road Lodge** – 4.9 km from ELICC
- **S.Sun Hemmingways** – 9.7 km from ELICC
- **Blue Lagoon Hotel** – 9.9 km from ELICC.

### Departure from East London

On the day of departure, delegates must check out of their hotel and bring their luggage to the ELICC. A secure lock-up facility will be provided at the conference venue for luggage storage. On Friday, a shuttle service to the airport will be available for all delegates, leaving at various times to accommodate flight departures. Please collect a timetable from the IMESA Info Desk near the ELICC entrance.

### Accommodation

### IMESA Annual General Meeting (AGM)

Everyone attending the conference (members and non-members) are invited to the IMESA AGM. The AGM, which will run for approximately one hour, will take place at the ELICC on Wednesday 26 October 2016, at 17:30 (after close of the last session).

### CPD Accreditation

The Continuing Professional Development (CPD) number for this conference is **IMESA16-CL30B**. Attending the conference ensures one full credit per day. Full attendance, including the technical tours will earn the delegates 2.5 CPD points.
